By splicing a pigtail to a fiber line, technicians can connect optical power meters, OTDRs (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometers), or other monitoring equipment without disrupting the main network. This allows for real-time performance checks, fault detection, and maintenance of signal integrity.

Types and Construction

- Simplex or multifiber pigtails: Single or multiple fibers for different network needs .
- Tight-buffered pigtails: Provide extra protection for the fiber core, suitable for harsh environments .
