They transmit data via light through thin glass or plastic cores, and even minor physical stress can cause signal loss or complete failure . A cable lying on the road is at risk of being crushed, bent, or damaged by vehicles, which can disrupt internet, phone, and other communication services for homes, businesses, and critical infrastructure . While the outer layers provide some protection, heavy vehicles or sharp impacts can break the fibers inside, requiring costly repairs.
