Types of Junction Boxes and Enclosures

Fiber Junction Boxes (also called optical splice closures or fiber joint boxes) are outdoor or underground enclosures designed to protect fiber splices from environmental hazards while providing mechanical strength and cable management . They are typically used for splicing, branching, and mid-span access in outdoor networks, and can be buried, pole-mounted, or installed in manholes . Fibre Optic Enclosures are generally indoor or sheltered outdoor cabinets used for fiber termination, patching, and distribution rather than raw splicing. They are often wall-mounted, rack-mounted, or floor-standing units in controlled environments . Junction boxes come in horizontal and dome (vertical) types, with capacities ranging from 24 to 192 fibers, depending on network requirements .

Splicing Methods

Fiber optic splicing is critical for maintaining signal integrity and network performance. The two main methods are:

- **Fusion Splicing:** Uses an electric arc to fuse two fiber ends into a single, seamless connection. It offers extremely low signal loss (often below 0.1 dB) and high reliability, making it ideal for long-haul and high-capacity networks .
