Overview of Fiber Termination

Fiber termination is the process of preparing the end of a fiber optic cable to connect to another fiber, network device, or patch panel. Fiber Splicing

Splicing is commonly used in long-distance networks, outside plant (OSP) installations, and situations requiring minimal signal loss. There are two main types:

- Fusion Splicing: Uses an electric arc to fuse two fibers together. It offers the lowest insertion loss (~ 0.1 dB), high durability, and is ideal for permanent installations and high-bandwidth applications. Fusion splicing requires specialized equipment and is not easily reversible.
