Fiber Optic Connectors

A fiber optic connector is a mechanical device that aligns and joins optical fibers, allowing light to pass with minimal loss. Unlike splicing, connectors are reusable, enabling easy connection and disconnection for maintenance and network flexibility. Key components include:

- **Ferrule:** A cylindrical part that holds and aligns the fiber core.
- **Connector body:** Protects the ferrule and ensures durability.
- **Attachment mechanism and boots:** Secure the connection and provide strain relief .
