A fiber-to-coax connection is achieved using a Hybrid Fiber-Coaxial (HFC) system, where fiber carries data to a neighborhood optical node and coaxial cable delivers the final connection to your home. This setup uses fiber for long-distance, high-speed transmission and coax for the last mile, enabling gigabit-class service without replacing existing coax infrastructure.

What an HFC Connection Is

- Hybrid Fiber-Coaxial (HFC) networks combine fiber-optic backbone lines with coaxial last-mile cabling.
- Fiber runs from the ISP's headend to a local optical node, where the signal is converted from light to RF.
- Coaxial cable then distributes the signal to homes or businesses.

How Fiber Connects to Coax

Key Components

Component	Function
Source Headend/Central Office	Generates DOCSIS broadband signals and sends them over fiber
Fiber Optic Cable	Carries high-speed, low-loss data to the neighborhood
Optical Node	Converts optical signals to RF for coax distribution
Coaxial Cable	Delivers the last-mile connection to the modem
HFC Modem (DOCSIS)	Interfaces coax with user devices
