The material of the internal alignment sleeve is arguably the most critical factor in an adaptor's performance and longevity. Phosphor Bronze: This is a metal alloy sleeve primarily used for multimode. The sleeve is responsible for maintaining concentricity, reducing lateral offset, and ensuring that insertion loss and return loss stay within industry requirements. LC and SC form factor Fusion-Splice Connectors shall be TIA/ EIA-604 FOCIS-3 (for SC) and FOCIS-10 compatible (for LC), and include a pre-polished fiber which eliminates the need for field polishing and adhesives. The connectors shall be composed of a ferrule assembly with integral fiber, a front. ed, connectors shall be constructed from the materials s ed as below in Table 2 in accordance with TIA-598-D or IEC-60304/IEC-304.
