

Fiber optic dual-mode to single-mode conversion

Why Direct Connection Fails

Multimode fiber (MMF) has a larger core (50 μ m or 62.5 μ m) compared to single-mode fiber (SMF, 8–10 μ m), which causes severe insertion loss and modal dispersion if connected directly. This mismatch can lead to complete signal failure, making conversion devices necessary for reliable communication .

Conversion Methods

1. Fiber Optic Media Converters

- Function: Convert optical signals from MMF to SMF by receiving the optical signal, converting it to an electrical signal, and retransmitting it as an optical signal suitable for the target fiber type.
 - Applications: Point-to-point links, extending LANs to WANs, connecting building networks over long distances.
 - Advantages: Supports multiple data rates and protocols (Ethernet, SONET), allows long-distance transmission (up to 140 km for Fast Ethernet, 80 km for Gigabit Ethernet), and avoids replacing existing fiber infrastructure .
