Using the wrong mode can cause signal loss or network errors. 3. Prepare the Patch Cord:

- Inspect the fiber end-face for dust or debris.
 - Use a fiber cleaning tool if necessary.
 - Avoid bending the fiber sharply; maintain the minimum bend radius.
4. Connect to the Transceiver:
- Align the connector with the transceiver port.
 - Insert gently until it clicks or seats fully.
 - For duplex connections, ensure the Tx (transmit) and Rx (receive) fibers are correctly oriented .
5. Verify Connection:
- Check link lights or network monitoring tools to confirm signal transmission.
