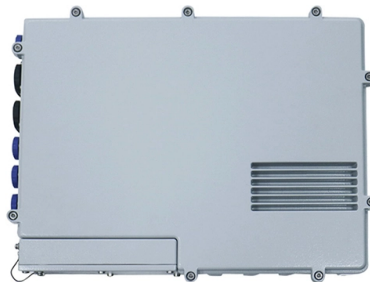

The connector end plugs into equipment, ODF ports, or splice trays, while the bare end is typically fusion-spliced to a trunk or distribution cable inside a splice tray or closure . Unlike patch cords, pigtails are designed for permanent splicing, so careful handling is essential to avoid damage.

Preparation

- Turn off connected equipment to prevent active signal transmission .
- Clean your workspace to minimize dust or debris.
- Wear anti-static gloves to prevent contamination of the fiber end .
- Have dust caps ready to protect the fiber once removed.
