- Distribution boxes or corridor panels: FTTH cables are spliced to pigtails before connecting to splitters or adapter ports.
- Terminal equipment connections: Pigtails connect the fiber network to ONTs or other devices, ensuring minimal signal loss.
- FTTH splitters: Some splitters come pre-terminated with pigtails for direct splicing, reducing connection loss and installation time .
