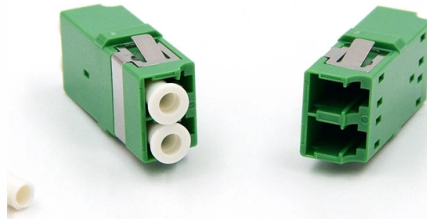


Fireproof cable tray rating

Fireproof cable trays are rated according to international, European, and North American standards that define fire resistance, circuit integrity, and material performance under fire conditions.

Key International and European Standards

IEC 61537 is the international product standard for cable tray and ladder systems, specifying requirements for support and accommodation of cables, but it does not directly address fire resistance. Fire performance in Europe is often evaluated using EN 1366 series, such as BS EN 1366-11 for cable systems and BS EN 1366-3 for penetration seals, which test the ability of cable trays and associated components to resist fire and maintain circuit integrity. In Germany, the DIN 4102-12 standard is widely used for fire-resistant cable trays. It requires testing the entire cable tray system in an oven at temperatures up to 1000°C for durations of 30, 60, and 90 minutes, ensuring that cables maintain circuit integrity during fire exposure. This is often referred to as an E30, E60, or E90 rating, indicating the number of minutes the system can withstand fire without failure.

North American Standards

In North America, fireproof cable trays are evaluated under different frameworks. NEMA VE 1 and CSA C22.2 No. 126.1 specify requirements for metal cable trays and fittings, while installation is governed by the NEC Article 392. For fire-resistive circuit integrity, standards like UL 2196 test power, instrumentation, control, and data cables under fire exposure and hose stream conditions, ensuring that cables continue to function during a fire. UL 2431 addresses the durability of fire-resistive coatings but is not a primary product standard.
