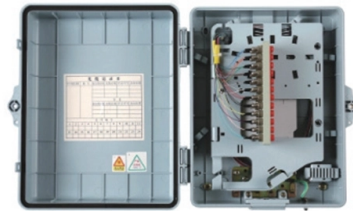


Fireproof cable tray support plate size requirements
