Overview

If the Neutral Conductor is opened, broke or lost at either of its source side (distribution transformer, generator) or at load side (distribution panel of a consumer), the distribution system's neutral conductor will “float” or lose its reference ground Point. Such neutral we call a Floating. The distribution box (DB box) helps safely and efficiently distribute electrical power. Today, electrical systems are essential for homes and industries. Single Phase Distribution Box generally consists of Double Pole MCBs, Single Pole MCBs, and RCCBs. The neutral conductor is designed to provide the return path for current and, more importantly, acts as the zero-voltage reference point for all 120-volt circuits in the home. When.
