

Gigabit ports can be used with 10G optical modules

- **Form Factor:** 10G modules use SFP+ or other 10G-specific form factors (XFP, X2, XENPAK), which are physically compatible with some ports but electrically incompatible with Gigabit modules.
- **Use Case:** Gigabit modules are suitable for general LANs and small enterprise networks, whereas 10G modules are required for high-speed, high-load environments like data centers.
