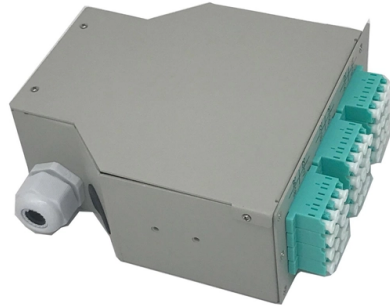


Haiti Trough Cable Tray Standard
