Relay Protection

A mains protection relay is an electronic device that monitors the electrical supply for abnormal conditions, such as overvoltage, undervoltage, frequency deviations, or loss of mains. These relays can automatically disconnect the supply to prevent damage to appliances, generators, or renewable energy systems (). For example, devices like MainsPro or IntelliPro are designed for installations with photovoltaic systems, generators, or cogeneration units, providing essential protection against grid faults and ensuring safe operation of distributed energy sources ().
