Typical Amperage Ratings

Residential electrical panels, also called breaker boxes or load centers, are designed to safely handle a maximum electrical current, measured in amperes (amps). Common household ratings include 100A, 150A, and 200A, with 200 amps being standard for most modern construction. Older homes may still operate with 60A or 100A, which is generally considered the minimum acceptable capacity, while very large homes with extensive electric heating or specialized equipment can have 300A to 400A service .

How to Determine Your Panel's Amperage

The most direct method is to locate the main breaker inside the panel. This is the largest switch, usually at the top or bottom of the panel, and its handle is marked with the amperage rating, such as “100A” or “200A” . Additionally, the manufacturer's label inside the panel door or on the metal enclosure often lists the maximum service current, confirming the panel's capacity .
