

How does fiber optic cable get into the core switch

Fiber Connection Process

- **SFP/SFP+ Transceiver Modules** Core switches typically have dedicated SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ slots for fiber connections. These modules act as the interface between the switch and the fiber optic cable, converting electrical signals from the switch into optical signals for transmission over the fiber and vice versa .
- **Fiber Cabling** Fiber optic cables used for core switch connections are usually duplex, meaning they have two strands: one for transmitting and one for receiving data. Multimode fiber is used for shorter runs (under 1000 feet), while single-mode fiber is preferred for longer distances (over 1000 feet), . The cables are often terminated with LC connectors, which plug directly into the SFP module .
- **Physical Connection** To connect the fiber to the core switch, the SFP module is inserted into the switch port, and the fiber strands are plugged into the module. It is important to ensure that the transmit (TX) and receive (RX) fibers are correctly aligned between the two devices (TX of one switch connects to RX of the other), .
- **Optional Media Converters** If a switch does not have SFP ports, a fiber media converter can be used. This device converts electrical signals from copper Ethernet cables into optical signals for fiber transmission, allowing integration with fiber networks without replacing existing switches .
