

How high should the home electrical distribution box be installed

A residential electrical distribution box should be installed so that the highest circuit breaker handle is no more than 6 feet 7 inches (2.0 meters) above the floor, with the bottom of the panel typically at least 12 inches above the floor for safety and accessibility.

Recommended Height

For indoor wall-mounted distribution boxes, the ideal height is generally 4.5 to 5.5 feet (1.4 to 1.7 meters) from the floor to the center of the panel, making it easily accessible without bending or stretching excessively and protecting it from minor water spills or impacts . For outdoor boxes, a minimum height of 3 feet (0.9 meters) above ground is recommended to avoid water and dirt exposure . Ground-mounted boxes should be slightly elevated, about 2 to 4 inches, to prevent moisture damage .

NEC Code Requirements

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC), the center of the grip of the highest circuit breaker handle must not exceed 6 feet 7 inches (2.0 meters) above the floor or working platform . This ensures that all breakers are within reach for an average adult, allowing safe and quick operation during emergencies. The NEC also requires a clear working space in front of the panel: at least 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high . Panels must not be installed in bathrooms, closets, or behind obstructions, and the working space must remain free from storage or equipment .
