Single-mode fiber (SMF) is the standard for long-distance communication because it transmits light along a single path, minimizing dispersion and signal loss. For example, OM2 multimode fiber supports 550 meters at 1 Gbps and only 82 meters at 10 Gbps.

Factors Affecting Long-Distance Transmission

- **Attenuation:** Signal loss occurs as light energy is absorbed or scattered in the fiber. High-quality fibers with low attenuation ratings allow longer spans.
- **Dispersion:** Light pulses spread over distance, potentially overlapping and causing errors. Single-mode fibers reduce chromatic dispersion, enabling longer distances.
