Factors Determining Circuit Capacity

- **Type of Circuit Breakers:** Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs), Residual Current Devices (RCDs), and Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters (GFCIs) occupy different amounts of space. Some boxes allow tandem breakers, which can increase the number of circuits without enlarging the box .
- **Electrical Load:** The total load of all connected circuits must not exceed the box's rated capacity. For example, a 15-amp, 120V lighting circuit should not exceed 1,440W, and a 20-amp circuit should not exceed 1,920W, following the 80% continuous load rule .
- **Future Expansion:** It is recommended to leave extra slots (around 20% more than current needs) for future additions like solar panels, EV chargers, or additional lighting circuits .
