Advanced SFP variants, such as compact SFP (cSFP) or SFP-DD (double density), allow two independent bidirectional channels per port, effectively connecting two fiber pairs (four cores) in a single module slot. These are primarily used to increase port density and optimize fiber usage in data centers .
