The area a distribution box can support depends on its rated current, number of outgoing circuits, and the type of load, rather than a fixed square meter value.

Key Factors Affecting Coverage

- **Number of Circuits and Load Type** A distribution box distributes power to multiple circuits through devices like MCBs, RCDs, and RCBOs. The total area it can support depends on the number of outgoing circuits and the load per circuit. For example, a 12-way box may be sufficient for a small residential unit, while an 18-way or larger box is better for larger homes or commercial spaces .
- **Rated Current and Short-Circuit Capacity** The rated current of the distribution box and the short-circuit rating determine how much electrical load it can safely handle. Higher-rated boxes can support more circuits and, consequently, a larger area .
- **Residential vs. Commercial Applications**
 - **Residential premises:** One distribution board is typically enough for a single home, including the meter, regardless of the exact square meters, as long as the total load does not exceed the box rating .
 - **Commercial or industrial buildings:** Larger or multiple distribution boxes may be required, with careful planning of busbar layout, neutral and earth bars, and cable entries to accommodate higher loads .
