Distribution Board or DB is an electricity supply system or a common enclosure that distributes the electrical power feed into subcircuits. It includes isolator, RCCB (Residual current circuit breaker) or RCD (Residual-current device) devices, protective fuses or MCB's (Miniature Circuit Breaker). Always begin with disconnecting the main supply before accessing any enclosure containing distribution components. This prevents arc faults and ensures safety when modifying or inspecting current paths. Inside the service housing, line conductors from the utility feed typically enter through the.
