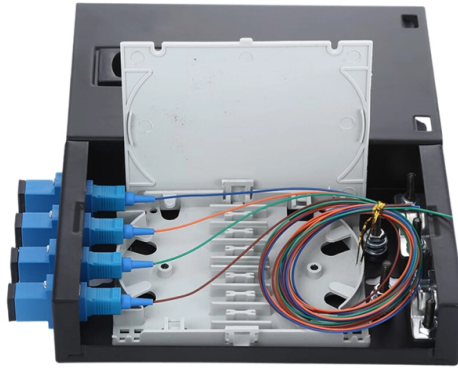

Types of Fiber Damage

- **Macrobends:** Large bends that exceed the cable's bend radius, causing light leakage and eventual breakage .
- **Microbends:** Small, often invisible bends caused by compression or tension, which gradually degrade performance and can lead to fiber fracture .
