

# How to check unused ports on a beam splitter

## Power Splitter

If testing the device, terminate the unused ports. Depending upon the port-to-port isolation characteristics of the splitter, terminating the other ports may not affect the readings on the port you

In the case of a 2-Way splitter that only has one port being used, it's probably best to just replace that splitter with a barrel connector, which then eliminates the loss in signal that the splitter induces, and

It was my policy to terminate unused distribution ports on splitters and taps but we didn't have to. There were no terminated unused wall plates or splitter ports in the customer premises.
