

# How to coil fiber optic cables at fiber optic splice boxes

### Key Principles for Coiling Fiber Optic Cables

- **Maintain Minimum Bending Radius:** Always ensure the fiber is coiled with a radius at least 10 times the cable diameter or no less than 30mm to prevent microbends and signal loss . Avoid sharp bends or tight loops.
- **Use Fiber Splice Trays:** Place spliced fibers in dedicated splice trays or grooves inside the enclosure. These trays help organize fibers, protect splices, and provide a structured path for coiling .
- **Reserve Adequate Fiber Length:** Before coiling, calculate the reserved length for each fiber to allow for future re-splicing or maintenance. Excess fiber should be coiled neatly without tension .
- **Coiling Methods:**
  - **Middle First, Then Sides:** Place the heat-shrink sleeves in the fixing groove first, then coil the remaining fiber on both sides. This method protects the splice and is useful when tray space is limited .
  - **Start from One End:** Coil the fiber from one side, fix the heat-shrink tube, and then coil the remaining fiber on the other side. This is faster and avoids sharp bends .
  - **Special Cases:** For fibers that are unusually long or short, coil them separately at the end or around special optical devices .
