5. Insert the Connector Align the connector with the port and insert gently until you hear or feel a click, indicating it is securely seated. Do not force the connector, as this can damage the ferrule or port .
6. Manage and Label Cables Use cable management tools like Velcro ties or trays to route the patch cord neatly. Proper labeling ensures traceability and reduces troubleshooting time in complex networks .
7. Test the Connection After installation, verify signal integrity using a visual fault locator (VFL) or optical power meter to ensure low insertion loss and proper return loss .
