Mechanical Attachment to Cabinets

- Splice plates or fish plates: Flat metal plates with pre-drilled holes can join tray ends to the cabinet or to other tray sections, providing a secure and adjustable connection.
- Quick-connect systems: Snap, slide, or twist mechanisms allow fast installation with minimal tools, suitable for modular setups or when using a single manufacturer's tray system. Ensure the tray is level and properly supported to prevent sagging, especially when fully loaded with cables.
