

How to connect the busbar in an electric blasting operation

Busbars in electric blasting setups must be connected with proper alignment, secure bolting, insulation, and safety precautions to ensure reliable and safe current distribution.

Preparation and Safety

Before connecting busbars, ensure all personnel are briefed on safety procedures and wear personal protective equipment (PPE), including insulated gloves and eye protection . Verify that the busbars are free of voltage and that the blasting area is clear of personnel . Inspect busbar sections for damage during transport and keep protective end caps in place until installation .

Alignment and Joint Assembly

- Remove protective covers from the busbar and joint blocks .
- Align busbar sections carefully, matching large alignment parts to large and small to small. Ensure conductors are clean and dry before assembly .
- Tighten adjunct bolts lightly to hold the busbar in place, then check alignment from multiple directions .
- Secure joint bolts with the recommended torque (e.g., 83 Nm) after confirming proper alignment .
- Install joint covers and adjunct lids to protect the connection.
