

How to equip a power distribution box with a power monitoring module

To equip a power distribution box with a power monitoring module, install the module in a suitable enclosure, connect current and voltage sensors, and integrate it with monitoring software or cloud platforms for real-time data access.

Step 1: Choose the Monitoring Module and Enclosure

- Feed the WHA-M harness connector and the current sensor interface cable (PPBUS) into the panel.
- Connect these to the WHA-F fuse harness or equivalent interface to measure branch circuits or mains ().
- Ensure proper grounding and follow electrical safety standards during installation.

Step 3: Integrate Sensors

- Current sensors (CTs): Snap-on or split-core CTs can be installed around live conductors without interrupting power ().
