

# How to extend the interface of indoor fiber optic cable

You can extend indoor fiber optic cables using pre-terminated fiber assemblies and media converters while carefully planning the cable path to maintain signal integrity.

### Planning the Extension

Before extending fiber, determine the final location of your Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or network device. Map the pathway through your home or office, prioritizing short, straight routes to minimize bends and stress on the fiber, which can cause signal attenuation. Avoid areas with high heat, foot traffic, or sharp edges, and consider using existing conduits or abandoned cable runs to simplify installation .

### Choosing the Right Cable

For indoor use, select riser-rated fiber optic cables. If running through plenum spaces, use OFNP-rated plenum cables to meet fire safety standards. Indoor cables typically use LC connectors with UPC polish (blue) for single-mode or multimode fiber. Avoid bending the cable beyond manufacturer specifications to prevent microfractures and signal loss .

### Using Media Converters

To extend fiber beyond typical Ethernet limits (100 meters for copper), use fiber-to-Ethernet media converters. Install one converter at each end of the fiber run:

- Connect the pre-terminated fiber cable to the media converters, ensuring proper polarity (strand 1 to 1, 2 to 2, or flip one end if needed).
