

How to identify circuit boards in a distribution box

To identify the circuit board in a distribution box, locate the main panel, examine the breakers or fuses, and systematically test each circuit while labeling them for clarity and safety.

Locate the Distribution Box

The first step is to find the distribution box, also called a consumer unit, load center, or panelboard depending on your region. It is usually near the entry point of the main electrical supply into the building, often in a utility room, basement, or garage . The box contains the main switch, busbars, neutral and earth bars, and individual circuit breakers or fuses .

Understand the Components

Inside the distribution box, you will typically find:

- Main switch: Disconnects the entire supply for safety .
- Busbars: Copper bars that distribute power to multiple circuits .
- MCBs or RCBOs: Protect individual circuits from overload or faults .
- Neutral and earth bars: Organize return and protective conductors .
- Labels: Indicate which breaker controls which area or appliance .
