

How to install an optical fiber distribution box

Installing optical fiber in a fiber distribution box involves preparing the site, mounting the box, routing and securing fiber cables, splicing or connecting fibers, and performing post-installation checks for signal integrity.

Pre-Installation Preparation

- Determine the installation location: Choose a dry, ventilated, and stable area. Indoor boxes should be mounted 1.2–2.5 meters above the ground, while outdoor boxes are typically 2.8–3.2 meters high. Avoid unstable walls, water pipes, high-voltage cables, and areas with heavy pedestrian traffic .
- Check the equipment: Ensure the fiber distribution box, interface boards, and protective sleeves are complete and undamaged. Prepare tools such as expansion bolts, levels, protective ground cables, fiber jumpers, cable hoses, and a fusion splicer .
- Select the appropriate FDB type: Wall-mounted, rack-mounted, or outdoor weatherproof boxes should be chosen based on network requirements and environmental conditions .

Mounting the Fiber Distribution Box

- Wall-mounted installation: Use anchors or lag bolts to secure the box to a concrete or brick wall. Ensure the box is level using a bubble level tool .
