

How to install the bow-shaped bracket on the cable tray



Summary of Content

Install the bow-shaped bracket by marking support points, securing it to the wall or ceiling, leveling it, and then attaching the cable tray with bolts or clips.

Step 1: Plan and Mark Support Points

Before installation, determine the cable tray route and spacing for supports. Standard intervals are typically 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load. - For ceiling-mounted brackets, drill into the structural slab and install drop-in anchors or threaded rods to support the bracket . Ensure the surface is clean and free of obstructions like pipes or HVAC ducts .

Step 3: Attach the Bow-Shaped Bracket

- Position the bracket against the wall or ceiling anchor points.
- Secure it using nuts, washers, and bolts, making sure the bracket is level and stable.
- If the bracket has adjustable arms, adjust them to match the tray height and slope requirements .
