Ensure that each breaker is rated for the specific load of its circuit and complies with standards such as IEC 60947-2 ().

Organize and Label Circuits

Clearly label each circuit to identify its load and purpose. This helps in maintenance, troubleshooting, and ensures that each circuit is correctly protected (). Use color-coded wiring and proper busbar alignment to reduce errors and improve safety ().
