

How to open the fiber optic distribution box

4. Handle fibers with care Fiber optic cables are fragile and can be damaged by pulling, bending, or crushing. Always maintain the minimum bend radius and avoid excessive tension on the fibers while accessing the box .
5. Re-secure the box after work After completing your work, close the door or panel until you hear an audible click from the clips or ensure the screws are tightened securely. Verify that all cables are properly seated in the clamps and grommets to prevent movement or damage .
