- Clean connectors regularly with fiber optic cleaning tools or pens before connecting .
- Avoid touching the fiber end face with fingers, as oils and dirt reduce optical performance .
- Inspect end faces with a fiber inspection scope to ensure cleanliness before and after cleaning .

Proper Bending and Routing

- Respect the minimum bend radius specified for each fiber type to prevent microcracks or signal loss .
