

How to secure the wires in a distribution box

Use cable clamps, staples, or straps approved by the NEC to secure wires within 12 inches of the box and at regular intervals along the cable.

Recommended Methods

Cable Clamps: Cable clamps are the primary method for securing wires entering a distribution box. They prevent movement, reduce mechanical strain, and protect insulation from wear or accidental disconnection. Common types include:

- **Screw-in clamps:** Metal clamps that screw into knockout holes in metal boxes and tighten around the cable.
- **Snap-in clamps:** Plastic clamps that snap into plastic boxes with spring-loaded tabs.
- **Squeeze clamps:** Two-piece metal clamps that squeeze around the cable.
- **Locknut-and-bushing clamps:** Provide strain relief for metal boxes with threaded openings.

Staples, Straps, and Cable Ties: For nonmetallic-sheathed (NM) cables, the NEC allows securing with staples, straps, hangers, or cable ties listed for securement. These should be installed so they do not damage the cable insulation. Staples should fit snugly without piercing the jacket, and insulated staples are preferred in high-authority or high-traffic installations.
