Strengthening the grounding of a distribution box involves using properly sized conductors, secure bonding, corrosion-resistant materials, and ensuring low overall ground resistance.

Proper Grounding Conductors

Use grounding wires that meet or exceed local standards. In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) wire is standard, while other markets may require 6 mm². For connections between the mounting plate and equipment like spindle plates, larger wires (e.g., 6 AWG / 13.29 mm²) can reduce resistance and ensure reliable grounding, especially for long cable runs or multiple devices .

Bonding and Connection Techniques

- Threaded studs and factory-preset points provide strong mechanical and electrical connections. Attach grounding wires to these points and ensure a second connection from the mounting plate to the central grounding point .
- Flexible copper braided tape is recommended for moving parts, such as hinged doors, to maintain consistent contact and reduce resistance .
- Use anti-loosening washers and proper torque to prevent connections from loosening over time .
