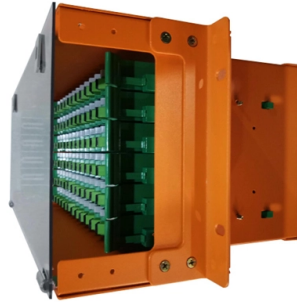


How to test after plugging and unplugging the optical module

After plugging and unplugging an optical module, testing ensures proper signal transmission, link integrity, and module functionality.

Step 1: Visual and Physical Inspection

Before testing, inspect the module and fiber connectors for dust, dirt, or damage. Ensure the module is fully seated in the port and the fiber jumper clicks into place. After unplugging, always use a dust cap to protect the optical interface .

Step 2: Verify Link Status

Check the host device interface to confirm the port recognizes the module. On network switches, commands like `display interface GigabitEthernet x/x/x` or `show interface` can confirm the link is up and the module's rate and wavelength match the datasheet .

Step 3: Optical Power Measurement

Use an optical power meter to measure the transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx) power levels. Compare the readings with the module's specifications to ensure the signal is within acceptable limits. This step helps detect fiber disconnections or signal degradation .

Step 4: Bit Error Rate Testing (BERT)
