

How to wire the distribution box to the electrical box

Step 1: Safety First

Before starting, turn off the main power supply to prevent electric shock. Use insulated tools and wear protective gear. Ensure the installation area is dry, accessible, and free from flammable or corrosive materials ().

Step 2: Mount the Distribution Box

Secure the distribution box to a stable wall or surface at an accessible height. Ensure it is level and firmly fixed using expansion bolts or screws ().

Step 3: Prepare the Wires

Strip the insulation from the ends of the incoming and outgoing wires, leaving enough exposed conductor to make secure connections. Follow standard color coding: typically, brown/red for live, blue for neutral, and green/yellow for ground ().

Step 4: Connect the Main Power

Attach the incoming live wire to the main terminal or main MCB (usually a double-pole MCB for single-phase systems). Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar and the ground wire to the grounding bar (). Ensure all connections are tight and secure.
