

How to wrap fiber optic cables around power poles



Overview

The attachment method is generally wrapping the cable around the power cable using special installation equipment called a "tug", but some manufacturers claim lashing or clipping the fiber optic cable to the power conductor is possible. Optical attached cable (OPAC) is a type of fibre-optic cable that is installed by being attached to a host conductor along overhead power lines. Installation is typically performed using a. Utilities build fiber optic networks in similar ways that others build them, aerial and underground, but they also mix aerial cables in their power distribution cables, sharing towers and poles. In order to do this, they use some very different types of cables. Wear rubber glove harness on all bucket trucks and aerial lifts. A body belt and safety strap for the bucket or platform must be used when the equipment is pulled around a piece of hardware under tension. The most common variety is carbon steel with a zinc coating. The zinc coating provides cathodic protection (CP) to the steel, meaning that red rust is prevented even on the cut ends.
