Conduit Considerations

- Indoor conduit is optional in controlled environments but recommended in commercial or industrial settings to protect cables from physical stress and facilitate maintenance .
- Conduit sizing should accommodate the widest point of the cable assembly, typically the pulling eye (~¾ inch), and pre-lubrication is advised to prevent damage during installation .
- Plenum-rated cables for air-handling spaces cost more than riser-rated cables, while armored cables for harsh environments range \$0.50–\$5 per foot .
