 - **SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable):** Supports LC fiber connectors, hot-swappable, suitable for standard industrial applications .
 - **eSFP (Enhanced SFP):** Monitors voltage, temperature, bias current, and optical power, providing enhanced operational reliability .
 - **SFP+:** Higher-speed version of SFP, more sensitive to electromagnetic interference, with tighter module cages and additional springs to reduce EMI .
 - **XFP (10 Gigabit SFP):** Provides 10 Gbit/s transmission, supports LC connectors, hot-swappable, larger than SFP+ .
