Step 2: Cable Installation in the Splice Box

- **Select Sealing Rings:** Choose sealing rings that match the cable diameter. Place two rings on the prepared cable end .
- **Insert the Cable:** Position the cable into the designated entry port of the splice box. For armored or loose-tube cables, ensure proper alignment with the grommets .
- **Grounding:** Connect and ground the cable's shield layer if applicable .
