

Installation height requirements for distribution boxes and cabinets



Overview

Wall-mounted boxes should be 4. This height makes it easy to reach without bending or stretching. Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches to avoid. The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1.5 feet (≈ 2 meter) high in front of the panel. The panelboard's door (hinged cover) shall be able to be opened to a full 90°. However, this height can be adjusted higher or lower appropriately for operational and maintenance convenience, provided design. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure ip67 and the ground should be greater than 1.
