

Installation of cable tray platform

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, review approved shop drawings to confirm tray layout, length, and routing within the building . Inspect the site to ensure it is clear of obstructions and safe for work, and coordinate with other trades to prevent interference . Verify that all materials, including trays, ladders, fittings, and accessories, are approved, undamaged, and stored properly to prevent moisture or sunlight exposure .

Selecting the Right Tray Type

Choose the tray type based on cable type, load, and environmental conditions. Ladder trays are ideal for power cables due to excellent ventilation and convenient cable anchoring points, while ventilated trough trays provide continuous support for smaller control or instrumentation cables . For corrosive or high-moisture environments, fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) trays offer corrosion resistance and non-conductivity .

Support and Mounting

Determine support spacing according to manufacturer specifications and total anticipated cable weight, typically every 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type . Common support methods include trapeze hangers for ceiling suspensions and cantilever wall brackets for vertical runs . Ensure trays are aligned, level, and securely fastened using appropriate clamps, brackets, and connectors .
