

Installing fiber optic cables on walls

Planning the Installation

Avoid areas with extreme temperatures, high foot traffic, or heat sources like uninsulated attics or near heating vents .

Selecting the Right Cable

For indoor wall installations, bend-insensitive fiber (BIF) is recommended. Modern single-mode BIF can handle tight bend radii as small as 7.5 millimeters without significant signal loss . Indoor fiber optic cables are typically fire-resistant and flexible, designed to meet safety standards while providing durability in controlled environments .

Routing and Protection

- Use protective conduits or innerducts when running fiber through walls or basements to prevent physical damage and abrasion .
- Never pull directly on the glass fibers; instead, pull on the cable's internal strength members, such as Kevlar aramid yarn, to avoid stretching or breaking the fiber .
